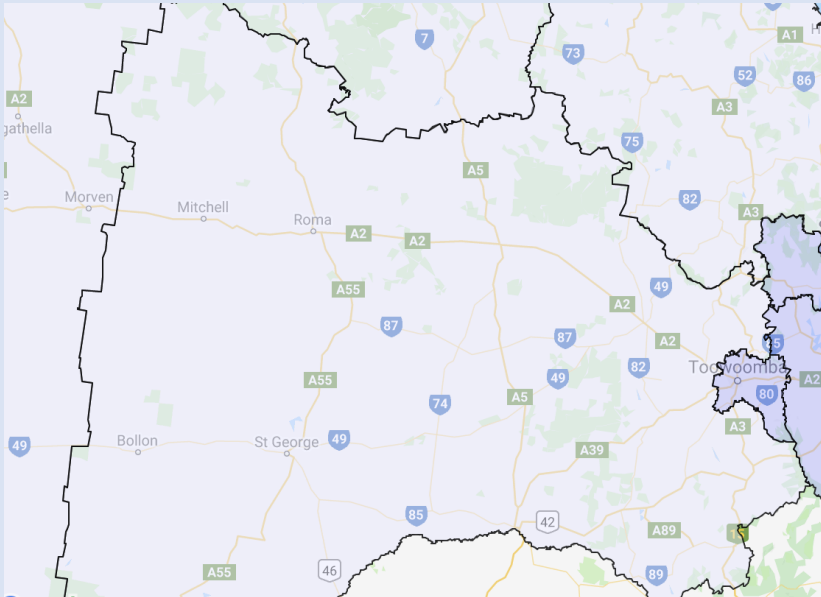

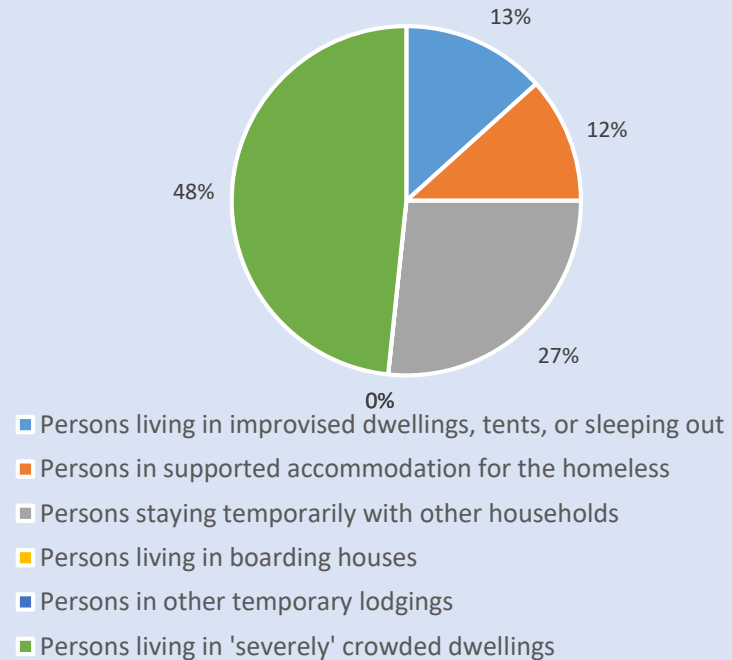
Young people in Darling Downs - Maranoa Region

There are 349 people who experience homelessness in Darling Downs - Maranoa Region on any given day according to the 2016 Census. Of these 58 were young people, accounting for roughly 17% of the total homeless population.



The majority of homeless were concentrated in the west of the region.

The data shows that most young people in the Darling Downs - Maranoa Region aged 12 – 24 years of age were in severely overcrowded dwellings and a significant group are couch surfers.
