## Young people on the Gold Coast


There are 1,723 people who experience homelessness on the Gold Coast on any given day according the to 2016 Census. Of these 296 were young people.

Due to the long and thin geographical nature of the Gold Coast most young people are in major centers or at transport hubs.


Anecdotal evidence has found that nearly 30% of young people who are homeless had an experience of rough sleeping. A smaller number were living in supported accommodation reflecting that there are only two funded services specially for young people in the region.

The data shows that most young people on the gold coast aged 12-24 years of age were living temporarily with other households or in severely overcrowded dwellings.
