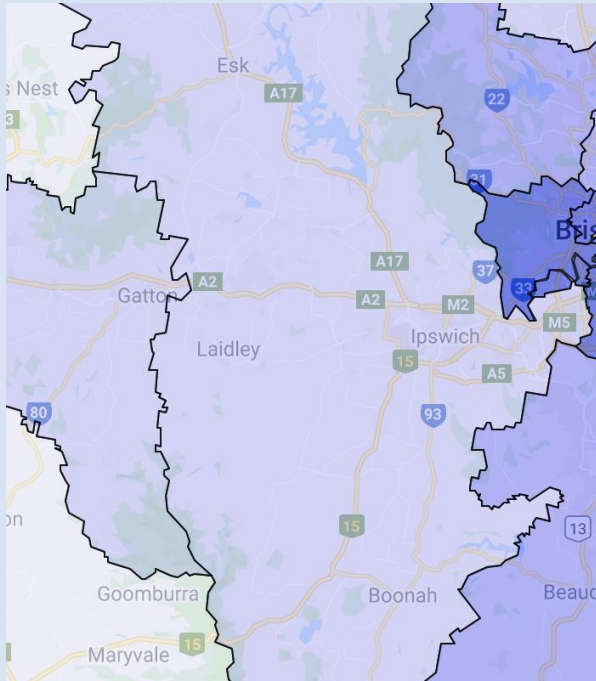

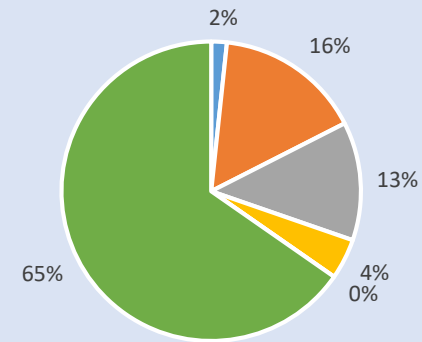
Young people in Ipswich Region

There are 1,223 people who experience homelessness in the Ipswich Region on any given day according to the 2016 Census. Of these 298 were young people, accounting for roughly 24% of the total homeless population.



Homeless population was spread across the Ipswich Region with no distinct concentrations.

Where young people experiencing homelessness are living by %



- Persons living in improvised dwellings, tents, or sleeping out
- Persons in supported accommodation for the homeless
- Persons staying temporarily with other households
- Persons living in boarding houses
- Persons in other temporary lodgings
- Persons living in 'severely' crowded dwellings

The data shows that most young people in the Ipswich Region aged 12 – 24 years of age were in severely overcrowded dwellings.
