


Young people in Logan - Beaudesert Region

There are 1,229 people who experience homelessness in the Logan - Beaudesert Region on any given day according the to 2016 Census. Of these 355 were young people, accounting for roughly 29% of the total homeless population.



The majority of people experiencing homelessness were concentrated in Browns Plains and Springwood/ Kingston.

Where young people experiencing homelessness are living by %



- Persons living in improvised dwellings, tents, or sleeping out
- Persons in supported accommodation for the homeless
- Persons staying temporarily with other households
- Persons living in boarding houses
- Persons in other temporary lodgings
- Persons living in 'severely' crowded dwellings

The data shows that most young people in the Logan – Beaudesert Region aged 12 – 24 years of age were in severely overcrowded dwellings.
