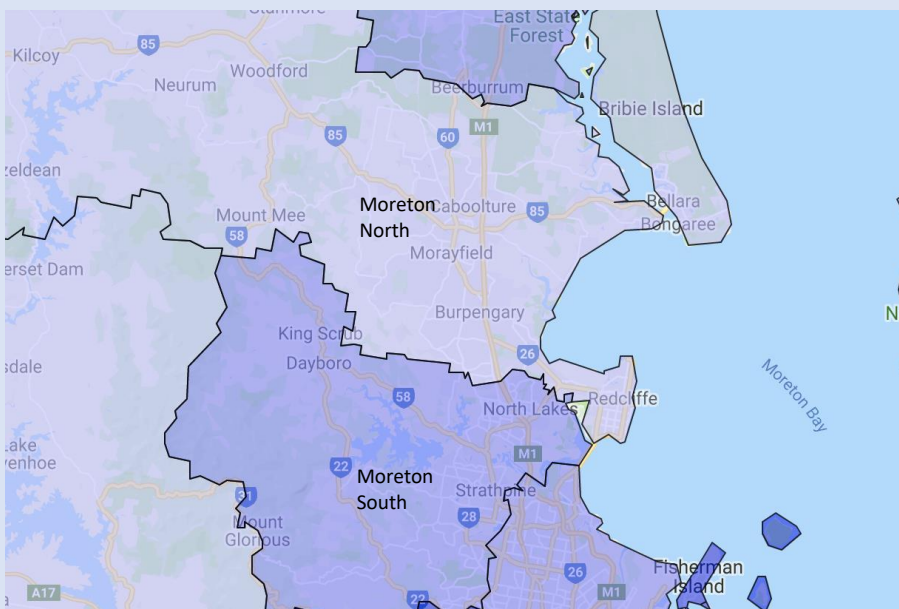

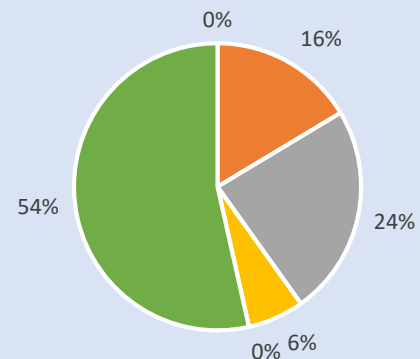
Young people in Moreton (North and South) Region

There are 1,179 people who experience homelessness in the Moreton Region on any given day according to the 2016 Census. Of these 296 were young, accounting for roughly 25% of the total homeless population.



Vast concentration in Caboolture in the North of Moreton Region and smaller population group in Burpengary and Redcliffe. Only small numbers in Moreton South.

Where young people experiencing homelessness are living by %



- Persons living in improved dwellings, tents, or sleeping out
- Persons in supported accommodation for the homeless
- Persons staying temporarily with other households
- Persons living in boarding houses
- Persons in other temporary lodgings
- Persons living in 'severely' crowded dwellings

The data shows that most young people in the Moreton Region aged 12 – 24 years of age were in severely overcrowded dwellings.
