WHO IS IT FOR?

Young adults 16-25 years who want to gain their driver licence, who may have experienced; difficulty accessing a vehicle or licensed driver, long term unemployment, learning difficulties, mental health issues, single parenting, migrant or refugee background and/or other significant barriers.

- Identification
- Education
- Accomplishment
- Employability
- Independence
- · Connection with community.
