WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

We can support people with disability who:

- Are between 18-65 years old
- Live in Brisbane, Gympie, Moreton Bay (Caboolture, Deception Bay & surrounds)
- Don't own a device or own an outdated device
- Need support to use their devices confidently
- Aren't eligible to get funding for a device through other programs.

Learn skills and digital **ability** to get online and stay connected.
